#### **Pool Guidelines**

(Please share these guidelines with your group before arrival at Silver Spur.)

Pool – The Lifeguard at the pool has complete authority in the pool area. Lifeguards and Silver Spur staff are the only ones authorized to have the combination to the pool locks. Lifeguards have the authority to ask anyone, including adults, to leave the pool area if they are behaving in an unsafe manner.

1. No one is allowed in the pool area without a certified lifeguard on duty (facility crews are exempt).

#### 2. Pool and Waterslide Swimsuit Policy

Silver Spur strives to provide a safe, family-friendly atmosphere at all times. To help accomplish this goal, only modest swimming apparel is allowed at Silver Spur. If a participant is wearing a 2-piece swimsuit that does NOT cover the midriff, we ask that they put a colored (not white) tank top or t-shirt over their swimsuit. If the camper does not have a shirt to dedicate to water activities, Silver Spur can provide one. Tankinis that cover the midriff are acceptable. The lifeguard and waterslide attendant maintain the right to reserve judgment regarding wearing a shirt or shorts over a swimsuit.

- 3. No climbing on or over the pool area fences.
- 4. No food or drinks are allowed inside the fenced pool area.
- 5. No running inside the fenced pool area. Those who violate this rule may be asked to leave the pool area.

#### 6. No diving.

- 7. No dunking or horseplay. No pushing or throwing anyone into the pool.
- 8. No playing with the lifesaving or pool cleaning equipment.
- 9. Please DO NOT take items from the recreation bag into the pool area. This shortens their life span significantly.
- 10. Pool lights must remain on whenever the pool is open after dusk.
- 11. Please make sure the GATES are LOCKED when finished in the pool area.

# Camp Clean-up Procedures for Guest Groups

Please help us keep Silver Spur clean! If everyone pitches in, the job will be a quick and easy one. Thank you!

## **Sleeping Rooms**

- 1. Tilt bunk bed mattresses on their sides and leave tilted. Clean all paper, etc. out from under the mattresses, and deposit in the trash. Look for any 'lost and found' items that may have fallen beneath the mattresses.
- 2. Sweep cabins thoroughly, including under the bunks and clothes racks. Deposit refuse in the trash can. No mopping is necessary, as the camp staff will take care of this. Remove all signs and banners from inside and outside of buildings and deposit in the trash.
- 3. Be sure to check for any personal belongings left in the bathrooms, as well as in the cabins.
- 4. Replace broom and dustpan back in the rooms when the clean-up is completed.

#### Restrooms

Place any trash that may be on the floor into the waste can.

#### **Meeting Rooms**

Remove all personal belongings and pick-up trash

#### Grounds

Pick up papers and trash from around the buildings, recreation areas, amphitheatre, field, along the creek and parking areas, and deposit in the trash. Be sure to check for personal belongings left on the grounds. Bring "found" items to the Lodge.



# **Directions to Silver Spur**


## FROM SACRAMENTO - IF TAKING HWY 49

- 1. Travel south on HWY 49/ Washington St.
- 2. Go through Sonora to HWY 108
- 3. Turn left onto HWY 108 East
- 4. Go approx. 1 mile to Mono Way Exit
- 5. Take the Mono Way Exit
- 6. Follow Directions below starting from #1



- 1. Take the Mono Way exit. Turn right onto Mono Way. (You will pass a Ford dealership on your left and a Dodge Dealership on your right.) Drive 1 mile
- 2. Turn right on Tuolumne Rd (E17)
- 3. Travel 4 miles on Tuolumne and turn right onto Woodham Carne Rd.
- 4. Travel 1.5 miles and turn slight left onto Yosemite Rd.
- 5. Travel 1.4 miles and turn right at the Silver Spur sign (Silver Spur Dr)
- 6. Drive 1.2 miles and end in parking lot

## **Policies and Reminders**

Silver Spur advises persons using its facilities to adhere to certain policies and codes which are a part of our code of ethics. It is the responsibility of the group leadership to notify every person of the following Policies and Reminders:

- 1. Smoking is allowed in designated areas only.
- 2. We do not allow alcohol, illegal drugs, immoral conduct, firearms, or fireworks.
- 3. Profane language is unacceptable.
- 4. Pets are not allowed on the camp grounds (service dogs are allowed). Must wear service vest at all times.
- 5. Cars must be parked in designated areas.
- 6. Bicycles or skateboards are not allowed on Silver Spur grounds.
- 7. Sports equipment may be reserved prior to arrival for use during encampment.
- 8. Towels, soap, and bed linens are also provided at an extra cost. Please request in advance. Replacement sets available for an additional fee.
- 9. Most AV equipment is provided without charge. If requested in advance, some sound equipment and other specialized equipment (i.e. LCD projectors) can be ordered for an additional charge.
- 10. Quiet hours are from 10:00pm-7:00am. No amplified sound or intentional loud noises outside after 10:00pm. This is a courtesy to groups that may be using other areas of the camp, and to our neighbors.
- 11. Agreed upon meal times must be closely observed in order to ensure optimal service.
- 12. Day visitors must register at the camp office, pay a minimal activity fee, and make arrangements for meals and any additional amenities. Prior notice is required. All guests will be required to adhere to camp policies.
